Queen Dierdriana appointed 6 of Lochac's finest as her guard but notification of this did not reach them during Her reign so these 6 wore their baldrics during the tourney. The 6 were Jock Cameron of Lochswan, James the Sinister, Robert Gordon of Ravensbrook, Haos Windchaser, Hugh Louis de la Lautrin, Sean the Wayfarer. Award of Arms was given to Lucerzia Lorenz. Flyer for 12<sup>th</sup> Night Feast.

Stephen of Drynor won the Progressive Melee and he and Haos fought in the semi final of the Viceroy Tourney. Haos lost to Brusi Anderson of the Sheltands (Politarchopolis) in the final round. Brusi and Alarice Beatrix von Thal will be invested at 12<sup>th</sup> Night. Borrowed armour will now cost from 50c to \$1.00 starting January 1<sup>st</sup>. New fighters have a grace period of 2 months to get armour together.

The formal one will be calligraphed and all those with an SCA name will be able to sign it.

A list of up coming principality and Kingdom competitions is included. 20th Year Celebrations flyer. New Lochac map included.

#### Irregular April 1986, AS20

April 12-13 – Hairy Star Watch – Mt. Crawford State Forest. Autocrat: Tovye Woolmongere. Archery, watching Halley's comet. April 26 – 20<sup>th</sup> Year Celebrations – Masonic Hall, Tusmore. Autocrat: Myfanwy O Dyfed. This was the first catered feast in Innilgard. Flyer included.

Notice was given of a college starting up at the University of Adelaide to be called the College of Blessed Herman the Cripple. Herman was a "blessed" rather than a "saint" as his work was not directly for the church. He was an 11<sup>th</sup>C Swabian and traditionally a feast was held on September 25<sup>th</sup>. Deformed from birth and confined to bed, he built musical and astrological instruments, wrote hymns and poems, learned Greek and Arabic and wrote a history of the world and a mathematical treatise. First Seneschal is Tako Ich'yama.

Flyer for the investiture of the first Baron and Baroness is included. Also a flyer for the first Blessed Herman Feast. Article on "Avoiding mundanity at SCA camping events" by Gereint The Scholar is included.

## Irregular June 1986, AS21

June 13 – College of Blessed Herman the Cripple First Feast – Upper Refectory. Cost \$4.00. Autocrat: Tako Ich'yama. Pot luck feast. June 21 – Investiture of the Founding Baron and Baroness – Masonic Hall, Tusmore. Cost \$9.00.

Haos and Bryony presented the shire's petition at Beltane Coronation (May 10) to Their Majesties James and Verena which was accepted and signed. So 3 years after the group started the shire has become a barony. At the same event Miriam Galbraith presented a petition on behalf of the newly formed College of Blessed Herman the Cripple and this also was accepted and signed by Their Majesties.

At Beltane a number of other things happened. River Haven were granted their petition and will have their investiture in August. Bryony of the Bees was given a Grant of Arms (for work as Lochac Seneschal, Thorfinn Hrolfsson was made Pelican and the first three knights in Lochac were made; Brusi Anderson of the Shetlands, Baron James the Sinister and Haos Windchaser. Haos also received the Order of the Silver Mantle (for looking good on the field and wearing reasonably period armour).

The College of Blessed Herman newsletter reproduces items of note in the Irregular so in the future college members will not receive this newsletter.

#### Irregular July 1986, AS21

At Baronial Investiture Brother John (Jean le Moutbank) was awarded the Order of the Rose Leaf. At their first baronial court, Baron Tovye and Baroness Aislinn made two proclamations and instituted the Order of the Fretted Goblet. The first recipients were Lillian Guy of Swanson, Bard Dragontower, Gereint Scholar, Bryony of the Bees and Haos Windchaser. Note: Bryony made the baronial cloaks.

At the same event Haos Windchaser won the Baroness's Championship fighting left handed. Two new fighters took the field: Bohdan Nepran and Arien merch Eynion.

The Baron and Baroness instituted a new order, that of the Order of the Knotted Noose, a blue noose presented to first time autocrats. Founding members were Osgot of Corfe, Arien merch Eynion and Bohdan Nepran.

Hassan Sharif ibn Ysau won the cooking competition at the Renaissance Toga Party and thus became the first recipient of the Gobbled Frette. Jade of Starfall won Crown for Anastasia of Starfall and will be the King and Queen at Lochac's first Coronet tourney. The tourney will be held on April 18 at the Rowany Festival. Investiture is at Midwinter on 11 July in Politarchopolis.
